### روسای محترم اتاق های بازرگانی، صنایع، معادن و کشاورزی سراسر کشور

### با سلام و احترام

طبق اطلاع واصله از وزارت امور خارجه کشورمان بر اساس اعلام سفارت جمهوری اسلامی ایران در دهلی نو، دولت هند از اوایل ماه مارس ۲۰۲۰ (تقریباً از نیمه اسفند ۱۳۹۸) به دلیل نگرانی های شدید ناشی از احتمال شیوع گسترده کرونا و متعاقباً اعلام قرنطینه سراسری از سوی نخست وزیر این کشور، اعمال محدودیت و ممنوعیت های متعدد بر صادرات اقلام و داروها و تجهیزات موثر بر درمان بیماران کرونایی را در پیش گرفته اند. گفتنی است بر اساس این بخشنامه ها صادرات ضدعفونی کننده ها، دستگاه های تنفس مصنوعی (ونتیلیتورها)، برخی از انواع ماسک ها (چون ماسک های N95) و همچنین برخی داروها نظیر داروی درمان مالاریا (هیدروکسی کلروکوئین) که در عین حال برای درمان بیماران کرونایی نیز مفید شناخته می شود، ممنوع اعلام شده و برخی اقلام دارویی دیگر نیز مشمول محدودیت صادراتی هستند. البته به نوشته رسانه های محلی ماسک های دو و سه لایه یکبار مصرف مورد استفاده در جراحی، تیغ های جراحی، ماسک های گاز و روکش های یکبار مصرف کفش از این ممنوعیت مستثنی هستند.

خواهشمند است دستور فرمایید مراتب به اعضای محترم آن اتاق اطلاع رسانی گردد و از نتیجه اقدامات این معاونت را مطلع فرمایند.

لازم به ذکر است تصویر ۴ مورد بخشنامه صادره اخیر از سوی اداره کل تجارت خارجی وابسته به وزارت بازرگانی و صنایع هند در این ارتباط جهت بهره برداری به پیوست ایفاد می گردد.

**Subject: - Amendment in Export Policy of APIs and formulations made from these APIs**

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, the Central Government hereby makes amendment, with immediate effect in Chapter 29(Organic Chemicals) and Chapter 30 (Pharmaceutical) of the Schedule 2 of the ITC (HS) Export Policy 2018, by inclusion of items, as indicated in the Table below:



**Subject: - Amendment in Export Policy of Masks, Ventilators and textile raw material for masks and coveralls**

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendment in Schedule 2 of the ITC HS Export policy 2018 related to export of Masks, Ventilators and textile raw material for masks and coveralls as per the product description given below:

2. The provision under Para 1.05 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2015-20 regarding transitional arrangement is not applicable for this notification.

**3. Effect of this Notification:**

The export of all ventilators, Surgical/Disposable (2/3Ply) Masks only and Textile raw material for masks and coveralls only falling under the ITC HS Codes specified against each has been prohibited, with immediate effect. All other items (except surgical/disposable (2/3Ply) Masks) allowed in the Notification No. 48 dated 25.02.2020 shall remain "free" for exports.

**Subject: - Amendment in Export Policy of Ventilators including any artificial respiratory apparatus or oxygen therapy apparatus or any other breathing appliance/device and Sanitizers.**

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendments:

A. Serial No. 207 B of the Schedule 2 of the ITCHS Export Policy in the Notification No. 52 dated 19.03.2020 related to export of Ventilators is amended as follows, with immediate effect:

2. The provision under Para 1.05 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2015-20 regarding transitional arrangement is not applicable for this notification.

**3. Effect of this Notification:**

The Serial No. 207 B of the Schedule 2 of the ITCHS Export Policy as specified in the Notification No. 52 dated 19.03.2020 is amended to the extent that the export of all ventilators including any artificial respiratory apparatus or oxygen therapy apparatus or any other breathing appliance/device falling under any ITCHS Code, including the ITCHS Codes mentioned above, is prohibited, with immediate effect.

The export of all Sanitizers falling under any ITCHS Code, including the ITCHS Codes mentioned above, is prohibited, with immediate effect.

The transitional arrangement under Para 1.05 of the FTP shall not be applicable.

**Subject: - Amendment in Export Policy of Hydroxychloroquine.**

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendments in the Schedule 2 of the ITCHS Export Policy related to export of Hydroxychloroquine and its formulations, with immediate effect:

2. The export of Hydroxychloroquine and formulations made from it, however, shall be allowed under following conditions:

- Export will be allowed from the SEZ/EOU Units and in cases where export is made to fulfill export obligation under any Advance license issued on or before the date of this notification.
- Export will be allowed in case of shipments where Irrevocable Letter of Credit (ILC) has been issued before the date of this notification or in case where full advance payment has been received by the exporter in India against specific shipment, subject to submission of documentary evidence.
- Exports will also be allowed by the Government of India to other countries on humanitarian grounds on case to case basis on the recommendation of Ministry of External Affairs.

**3. Effect of this Notification:**

The export of Hydroxychloroquine and formulations made from Hydroxychloroquine falling under any ITCHS Code, including the ITCHS Codes mentioned above, is prohibited, with immediate effect. Export shall, however, be only allowed in the conditions mentioned in the Para 2 above.
